Kollam was once the port of international spice trade. 30% of this historic town is covered by the renowned Ashtamudi Lake. The eight hour trip between Kollam and Alappuzha is the longest backwater cruise in Kerala. ”

Route to our resort By Road

An excellent road network links Kollam to all major towns and cities in Kerala. KSRTC operates Deluxe, Express and Fast Passenger, buses connecting important towns in the state.

Nearest Railhead

Kollam is an important railhead of the Southern Railways. Railway Station at Kollam is situated just 1 km from the heart of the town, Chinnakkada and 15 km from the resort.

Nearest Airport

Nearest Airport is Thiruvananthapuram International (71 km) and Domestic Airport is 76 kms away from the city.

Facilities in the Resort

What are the places of interest?

Ashtamudi (it means 8 armed or 8 branches) Lake is the gateway to the backwaters, located in Kollam district. Ashtamudi is famed for its panoramic views. There are coconut groves and palm trees all along the banks of the lake. This endless stretch of nature is only broken by the quiet town of Kollam. Kollam, also known as the land of cashew nuts, is also the southern gate way to the backwaters of Kerala.

Thangasseri

It is situated 5 km from Kollam town. The chief attraction of the place is the light house, built in 1902. The 144 ft. light house stands as a sentinel, warning seamen of the treacherous reefs of Thangassery. Visitors are permitted to visit the lighthouse between 3.30pm and 5.30pm.

Matha Amrithanandamayi Ashram, Vallikavu

It is the residence and head quarters of Matha Amrithanandamayi one of India's great Gurus, and is situated at Amrithapuri near Vallikavu. There are frequent buses from Kochi and Thiruvananthapuram to Karunagappally from where there are local buses to Vallikavu.

Chavara

Chavara is situated 14 kms, north of Kollam on the Kollam-Alappuzha road. Four major industrial establishments - Indian Rare Earths, The Kerala Premopipe factory, Kerala Minerals and Metals and the Titanium complex - are at Chavara. The Thalappoli Mahotsavom - offerings of lighted lamps in decorated small pans - in the Kottamkulangara temple here is very famous. It falls in March - April. The interesting features of the festival is that men dress themselves as women and carry lamps. This is a time-honoured custom

Mayyanad

It is about 10 km south of Kollam town. Mayyanad is famous for its shrines and temples. Subramanya Temple at Umayanallor is the most important among the nine temples of this area. The shrine is said to have been consecrated by the great Hindu philosopher Sree Sankaracharya.

Sasthamkotta

It is 29 km from Kollam town and is the largest fresh water lake of Kerala which is surrounded by hills on three sides. It is a beauty spot, a health resort and a centre of pilgrimage. The ancient Sastha Temple which lends its name to the town, is an important pilgrim centre. There are frequent buses from Quilon. The journey takes one hour.
