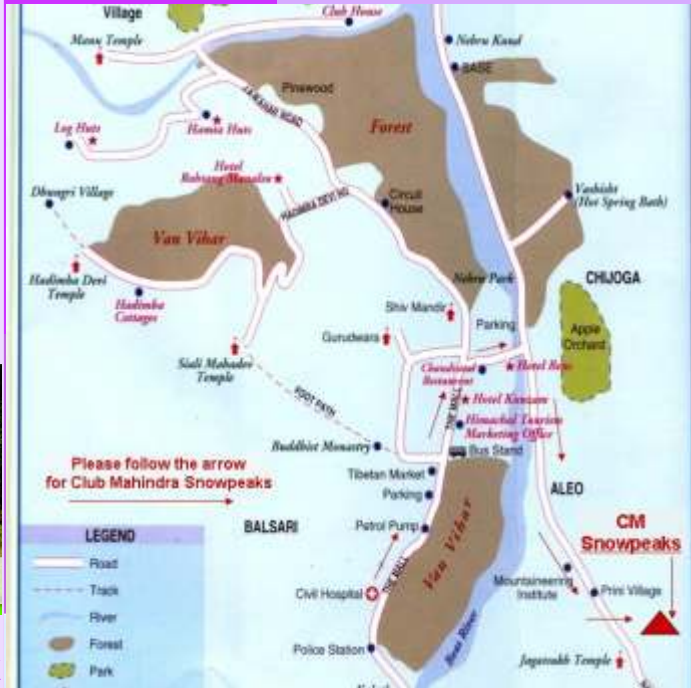

Hidimba Devi Temple



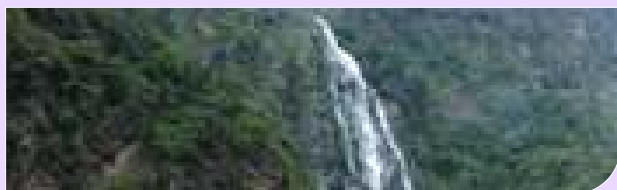
Manali has many attractions but the chief centre of interest, historically and archeologically, is undoubtedly the DHOONGRI TEMPLE dedicated to goddess Hadimba, the Bhim of Mahabharat fame. It has a four-tiered Pagoda shaped roof and the doorway is carved with legendary figures and symbols. This temple located amidst wooden forest of deodar is about 2.5 kms. from the tourist office. It is a pleasant experience to stroll in the temple complex which was built in 1533 A.D. A large festival is held here in May..

Rohtang Pass



Rohtang pass is 51kms. from Manali on the highway to Keylong/Leh. Rohtang Pass offers spectacular mountain views. Rohtang pass is open from June to October each year although trekkers can cross it earlier. Rohtang Pass is a gateway to Lahaul Spiti, Pangi and Leh valley just as Zojila pass is a gateway to Ladakh. There are beautiful sights of glaciers and peaks. The Chandra River flows down into the Lahaul valley. Slightly to the left are the twin peaks of the Geypan. During summer (mid June to October) regular buses ply between Manali - Keylong / Darcha, Udaipur, Spiti and Leh.

Beas Kund



The famous Beas Kund, the source of the Beas River, is situated at the Rohtang Pass. It is said that the great Rishi Vyas meditated here. The place is still hallowed by a celestial light. It is because of this the river got the present name of Beas.

Tibetan Monasteries



There are 3 newly constructed colorful Monasteries in Manali. The Tibetans living around these Monasteries in Manali offer a wide range of Tibetan Handicrafts and Carpets on sale. Two of these Monasteries are located in the main down-town of Manali and one Monastery in Aleo. Aleo is located on the Left Bank of River Beas in Manali.

VASHIST HOT WATER SPRINGS AND TEMPLE (3 kms)

Vashist, a small village located on the Left Bank of River Beas in Manali towards Rohtang pass is worth a visit. Vashist Hot Water Springs and Temple is renowned for its Hot Water Springs and Temples. Nearby is the Pyramidal Stone Temple dedicated to Vashist Muni. There is another Temple of Lord Ram as well. Here one can relax in natural sulphur hot water springs with two separate bathing tanks for gents and ladies. Needless to say, this place is always full of tourists. Turkish style shower fitted baths have also been built, where water is provided from the natural hot water spring nearby.

NAGGAR

Situated on the left bank of river Beas, Naggar was the capital of Kullu for approximately 1400 years. Nestling on a wooded slope, it commands a splendid and extensive view of the valley. The paintings of late Nicholas Roerich can be seen at the Roerich museum in a white washed villa set in a jewel like garden. Naggar Castle built in the sixteenth century is a huge building and is a great tourist attraction. Naggar has a number of famous temples, the important ones being Gaurishankra temple, Vishnu temple and Krishna temple.
